The first magazine containing chess articles published in Romania.

Costin is considered to be the founder of modern correspondence chess in Romania. During 1912-1913 he organized the first correspondence chess championship ever held in Romania. He was also the author of other less known works, not related to chess, which are interesting to list, in order to complete his portrait:
