

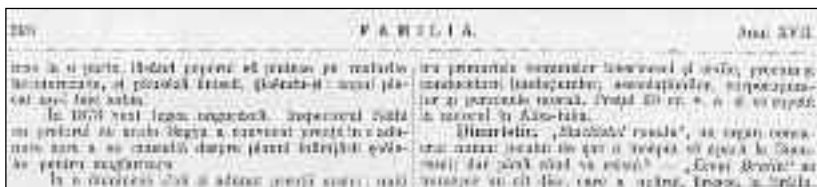
# CHESS MAGAZINES



## SIACHISTUL ROMÂN

**A magazine which have never appeared!**

In the newspaper **Familia** from Oradea-Mare, 16/28.viii.1881, was published an announce about a new chess printing.



**Diuaristic. „Siachistul român”, un organ consacrat numai jocului de șac a început să apară la București; dar până când va exista? —**

But the term “organ” was wrongly considered “magazine” instead of “column”, so in Publicațiunile periodice românești (ziare, gazete, reviste) = *Romanian periodicals (newspapers, gazettes, magazines)* by Nerva HODOȘ, Al. Sadi IONESCU, București, 1913, at letter “S” was mentioned:

*Sachistul român. București. Aug. -? 1881.  
Newspaper exclusively dedicated to chess.*

From that moment on, in many other chess publications, this information was used without any other proofs.

And now the truth. In fact it was an article published in **Resboiul român** newspaper, no. 268, Anul III, 6.ii.1881, entitled Șiachistul Român din Paris (*The Romanian chess player in Paris*), about Hercule A. Gudju.
