

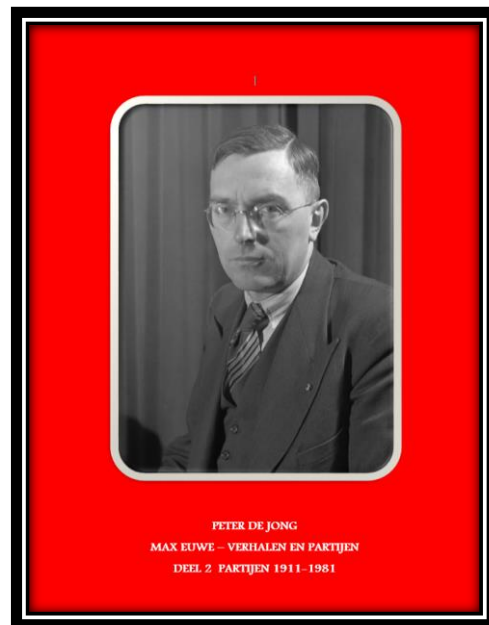
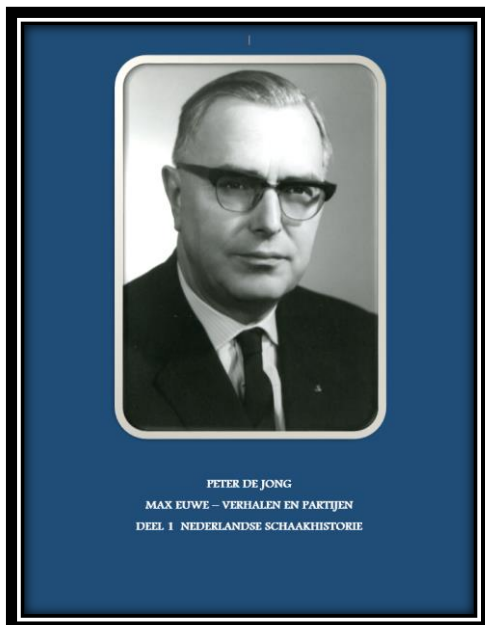
On 15 December 2015 it is exactly 80 years ago that Max Euwe became the 5th world chess champion.

This moved Peter de Jong to publish two books with over 1.000 pages on Euwe and Dutch chess history in this celebration year.

In the books you will find:

- All the (found) games Euwe played from 1911-1981;
- A chronologic overview of his career with all results and tables from 1911-1981;
- The unknown Euwe as a club player, in correspondence chess, has last unknown tournament in 1976 and more;
- The Euwe visit to the Dutch Indies in 1930;
- Chess in the Netherlands before and since Euwe;
- Over 50 biographies on leading Dutch players;
- Original comments, no computer analysis.

Part 1 has 363 pages with games and illustrations, a lot from private sources. Publication is scheduled for early September 2015. Part 2 has over 600 pages. Publication is scheduled for early December 2015. Please see the excerpt for further information.



Both books will be privately printed in an edition of 100 copies. These will be hardcovers, full color cover and black and white printing. There will also be a limited edition signed and numbered of 25 hardcovers copies with full color cover and full color content. The presentation of the books will be held around the 15th of December in Amsterdam at the Max Euwe Centre.
