

### **Efim Bogoljubow**

The book contains all chess columns published in the magazine "Badische Illustrierte" over the period given (not cited in Ken Whyld's *Chess Columns*): 192 chess problems – 61 of them are marked as originals, 74 recorded with sources (therefore reprinted); it seems that about the half of the rest of 57 problems are originals as well. Ten of the originals have been composed by Bogoljubow himself. In addition there are ten games and game fragments, three photographs and two chess cartoons. The accompanying texts and solving comments by Bogoljubow have been taken verbatim apart from corrections of orthographic and grammatical errors. The problems and games are registered in indexes of authors and of players respectively.
